## **The Elizabeth Grady School Campus Community and Safety Mission**

The Elizabeth Grady School of Esthetics and Massage Therapy is committed to providing a safe and positive learning environment to a diverse community of students. We empower students through quality education in Esthetics and Massage Therapy. Emphasis is placed not only on theory and technique, but also on personal growth, development of self-awareness, and innovation within the industries. Through technical knowledge and sense of touch, Elizabeth Grady professionals in turn empower the public by promoting whole health, wellness, and beauty from the inside out.

An important component of this commitment is providing standards and best practices for personal and public safety. Creating a safe and supportive environment becomes the responsibility of the entire community. The school administration and faculty are accountable in contributing to this effort to support the unique needs of each one of our students.

With this in mind, the information provided herein is intended to provide information and guidelines for how to most effectively contribute to the creation of a safe campus community. These guidelines also represent one of our efforts to comply with the Crime Awareness and Campus Security Act of 1990, the Jeanne Clery Act of 1998, and the Violence Against Women's Reauthorization Act of 2018.

## **The Elizabeth Grady School of Esthetics and Massage Therapy Campus**

The Elizabeth Grady School is located at 222 Boston Avenue in Medford, MA near Tufts University. All classes are held within the five-story beige, brick building located at 222 Boston Avenue. The Elizabeth Grady Companies also own the building located next door at 230 Boston Avenue, however no classes are held at this location. The adjoining parking lot and gated garden area comprise the Elizabeth Grady campus. Elizabeth Grady does not provide any student housing.

## **Security and Security Awareness**

The building located at 222 Boston Avenue houses all classrooms for makeup artistry, esthetics, and massage therapy classes. Security cameras exist on both the front and rear sides of the building and monitor activity outside 24 hours a day. An additional security camera is placed inside the building lobby.

We remind our students and staff to always be aware of your surroundings and to travel outside of the building in groups to assist in additional safety measures.

The Medford Public Police Department and Tufts University Campus Police regularly patrol the surrounding areas. They are aware that the Elizabeth Grady School of Esthetics and Massage Therapy educate a student body with a large percentage of

women and have an increased awareness of the special safety needs of our community.

During evening hours the school employs a janitorial crew. This group of men and women are an important part of helping to maintain a safe environment for our night students. We always recommend student leave in groups as they walk to their cars as a safety and awareness best practice.

Additionally, the school encourages every student and staff member to participate in helping to maintain a safe and supportive environment. Like a typical neighborhood watch program, students are expected to report any incidences of theft, damage to personal or school property, violence or violent threats, and/or drug and alcohol use. The Elizabeth Grady School maintains a zero tolerance policy for drug or alcohol use on campus. ## **Reporting Crime**

Cate Tool, School Director, is the designated contact person for reporting campus security issues and any crimes committed on campus. Members of the Elizabeth Grady School community are encouraged to report all crimes and incidents that could potentially threaten community safety.

In an emergency situation, the Medford police should be contacted directly by dialing 911. If a cell phone is not available, telephones are located on each floor throughout the building. Prior to dialing 911 from a school phone the caller should first dial 9 to access the outside line. Since the institution does not have private campus based security personnel, all campus law enforcement issues are referred to the Medford, MA police department. Students are encouraged to save their direct phone number in their cell phone contacts: 781-396-9400.

Reporting suspected crime is important so that we may better develop methods of prevention to assure student safety. In-turn, any reported crime will be reported to the Medford Police department and logged by school administration. A safety alert may be issued for any serious or continuing threat to the campus community. This alert will be issued immediately upon determination that there is a credible threat. Alerts will be issued in the form of, or combination of: email, announcement, and/or posting in common areas of the school.

## **In case of an emergency**

### **Dial 911**

If you need to report a situation or incident that is a possible threat to campus and/or student safety, please report it directly to an instructor or school administrator. All campus safety issues will be handled by the school director and/or the Medford Public Police.

## **School Emergency Evacuation Procedures**

In case of fire or emergency requiring evacuation of the building, the following procedure should be followed. Emergency evacuation procedures are reviewed when each class enters the program the first day. Students are instructed to remain calm and quiet and listen for directions from their instructors. When in a group, students should fall into a single-file line and exit building through stairwells and out, away from the building. Exit signs are located throughout the school and hallways. In the case of an emergency, elevators should not be used. In case of heavy smoke, crouch to knee level. Emergency evacuation and response procedures are regularly reviewed in monthly staff and faculty meetings.

## **Timely Warning Policy**

Upon report or discovery of a campus emergency, School Administration shall evaluate the situation and confirm that there is a significant campus emergency or dangerous situation on campus. Upon confirmation, Administration shall convene to evaluate the extent of the emergency and to determine the appropriate segment(s) of the campus community to receive notification. The content of any emergency notification, as well as the appropriate segment or segments of the community to be notified, will be determined by this team. Decisions to act are made on a case-by-case basis, but if a decision to notify is made, these individuals will use one or a combination of the following:

### **Emergency Notification Methods**

**Fire Alarm System:** When a fire alarm is sounded, everyone must immediately vacate the building and walk calmly to the designated area.

**Main School message for incoming callers-** At the direction of Administration, the incoming message will reflect the emergency, which will override the existing incoming school message.

Broadcast e-mail notification- At the direction of Administration will disseminate a broadcast e-mail throughout campus indicating the nature of the emergency.

Notification signage- At the direction of Administration, Personnel will post notification signs at all entrances to Elizabeth Grady School indicating the nature of the emergency.

Community notification- In the event that a significant emergency or dangerous situation exists which may affect the greater community surrounding the school, and at the direction of Administration, information will be made available via employee and student e-mail, the school website ([www.elizabethgrady.edu](http://www.elizabethgrady.edu)), and social media channels. The safety of the community will be taken into account and, without delay, the notification system will be implemented, unless issuing a notification will, in the professional judgment of responsible authorities compromise efforts to assist a victim or to contain, respond to, or otherwise mitigate the emergency.

## **Winter Storm Closings**

We are aware that many of our students travel from various places to attend school. It is important that student safety extend beyond the perimeter of our campus and that students use their best judgment when choosing to travel to and from school during inclement weather conditions.

Cancellations are posted on WHDH Channel 7 website, [www.whdh.com](http://www.whdh.com), and on FOX 25 television and [www.myfoxboston.com](http://www.myfoxboston.com).

The decision to cancel night programs is determined no later than 6:30 a.m. the same day of scheduled classes and 4:00 p.m. for evening programs.

## **Campus Safety and Student Privacy Policies**

Listed below are select policies excerpted from the Elizabeth Grady School Policies and Procedures Student Handbook. It is important that each and every student feels safe, both physically and emotionally. The following policies have been created in an effort to do so and to insure a sense of privacy for all who attend classes at the Elizabeth Grady School.

- Interaction and communication with school administration, faculty, and student body shall be mature, professional, and courteous at all times. Use of profane language, inappropriate conversation, and rude behavior is strictly prohibited.

- Vandalism or theft of school or other's personal belongings will result in immediate expulsion.
- Use of drugs or alcohol or being under the influence of these substances is strictly prohibited and basis for immediate dismissal. Possession and/or sale of drugs or any illegal substance will be reported to the Medford Police Department.
- Students are prohibited to use offices and practical classrooms without permission from an instructor or unless an instructor is present. Please use theory, library, and break room for studying. The fifth floor reception area and instructor's offices are by appointment only.
- Students are prohibited from smoking on the premises of 222 Boston Avenue and 230 Boston Avenue, Medford, MA. This includes anywhere in the building as well as the parking lot and adjoining sidewalks. Failure to comply with this policy may result in expulsion.
- Students must provide the school with written permission to release any information regarding the student's progress or to make any recommendation.
- All concerns regarding a student's education including, but not limited to: attendance, academics, financial, and personal situations should be brought to the attention of the appropriate instructor or administrator by the student. No calls from any other party will be entertained except for in the case of a minor student and parent or guardian or with express written consent from the student to do so.
- No photographs or video are allowed to be taken in, on, or around school premises without consent of the school and student/students.

## **Internet and Social Networking Policy**

The Elizabeth Grady School recognizes that Social Networking (such as personal websites, blogs, Facebook, Twitter, online group discussions, text messaging, message boards, chat rooms, etc.) is used by many of our students. The School respects the right of our employees to maintain a blog or post a comment on social networking sites. However, the School is also committed to ensuring that the use of such communications serves the needs of our educational institution and our students by maintaining the identity, integrity and reputation of the School and our student body in a manner consistent with our values and policies. In addition, in light of the nature of our business, there are also risks for HIPAA violations whenever anyone posts any information which may be prohibited by law. Further, the School has an interest in protecting its name, logo, and other intellectual property and in making sure that its students and employees do not violate criminal or civil law; student and client privacy or rights; or Company and School policy. Please make sure that you are aware of your obligations in this regard.

To protect the School, Students, Company, and Employees all students and staff are expected to adhere to the following rules:

- Students may not post on a blog or social networking site during their class time or at any time using School equipment or property. The School's electronic communication systems are for educational and business use only.
- If a student identifies himself or herself as a student of the Elizabeth Grady School of Esthetics and Massage Therapy on any social networking site, the communication must include a disclaimer that the views expressed do not necessarily reflect the views of the School or Elizabeth Grady Company.
- All rules regarding confidential information between students, instructors, administration, and clients apply in full to blogs and social networking sites. Any information that cannot be disclosed through a conversation, a note or an e-mail also cannot be disclosed on a blog or social networking site. The transmission of confidential patient material or other confidential or proprietary information, without the permission of the client or the School, is prohibited.
- Any conduct which is impermissible under the law if expressed in any other form or forum is impermissible if expressed through a social networking site. For example, posted material that is discriminatory, defamatory, libelous or malicious is forbidden. The School's policies, including but not limited to Student's Right to Privacy and professional and respectful interaction and communication between peers and faculty, apply equally to student comments on social networking sites even if done off school premises during personal time. Students are encouraged to review those sections of the Handbook for further guidance.
- Students are prohibited from misappropriating or using without permission the School logo and the School's intellectual property on any social networking site or other online forum. This includes, but is not limited to, exam materials and content, Elizabeth Grady textbook materials, and handouts. Students are reminded that there are civil and criminal penalties for posting copyrighted material without authorization.

## **Violence Prevention and Discipline Policy**

The Elizabeth Grady School strives to create a safe and supportive environment for our students. Expectations of student conduct and professionalism are reviewed during Orientation on the first day of classes. The Elizabeth Grady School Policies and Procedures clearly outline the expectation of its students to be professional, courteous, and respectful at all times in addition to several other professional behaviors (Please see Elizabeth Grady School Policy Handbooks for Esthetics and Massage Therapy.)

Behavior that is deemed unprofessional or disrespectful is dealt with immediately as soon as a member of the school faculty or administrating is made aware of the situation. Examples of prohibited behaviors include, but is not limited to, alleged dating violence, domestic violence, and/or stalking.



Any alleged complaint whereby a student is accused of engaging in or exhibiting inappropriate sexual or violent behaviors, i.e. dating violence, domestic violence, stalking, sexual assault or sexual harassment will be investigated by the school and may result in immediate dismissal and reported to Medford Police.

Students who may be affected by dating violence, domestic violence, stalking, sexual assault or sexual harassment off-campus in relationships with others who are non-students or not employed by the Elizabeth Grady School are provided with support services contacts and are recommended to report these situations to their local police department.
